

RED BLENDS

Vergenoegd – Runner Duck (Stellenbosch)

Complex and full bodied, sweet ripe fruit and a hint of cedar. Liquorice, spice and a white chocolate finished nose. With a berry, vanilla spice and tobacco leaf aftertaste.

Raka - Quinary (Stanford)

A deep ruby colour. This Bordeaux blend reveals a complex nose of spice, blackberries, a touch of mint and cigar box. The wine is well balanced, with a full mouth feel which will improve with ageing up to 8 years.

Montepulciano d'Albruzzo (Italy)

R260

An intense red colour, with a pleasant bouquet, elegant with delicate aromas of red berries. Full-bodied, the palate is dry, soft, with pleasant, light tannins.

Ataraxia – Serenity (Hermanus)

R330

Aromas of dark berry fruit, mineral and spicy notes. Refined, polished tannins, elegant structure. Ethereal, yet assertive.

Chianti (Italy)

R340

Beautiful cherry red hues, the fragrant violet and Marasà cheal taste is characterized by a very clean, freshness, pleasant and a good concentration accompanied by moderate tannins.

Creation (Hermanus)

R360

Aromas of ripe black olive and whiffs of pepper. Full-bodied Rhone-style blend, flavours of ripe plum, black pepper and smokiness. Supple ripe tannins and a natural acidity.

Springfield - Work of Time (Robertson)

R380

It was our desire to produce a classic blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich, classic and complex from age – of vines and wine.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

DC Reserve – Terra Hutton (Darling)

Fruit-driven, dark, intense colour. Blackcurrant, cherry, tobacco and dark chocolate nose. A good concentration of soft tannins and well-integrated wood flavours.

Hoopenberg - Bushvine (Stellenbosch)

R170

Red fruit dominates, notes of raspberries. Palate: A smooth, rich, meaty multi-layered wine with good freshness .

Graham Beck Game Reserve (Stellenbosch)

Great complexity of black berry fruit, dark chocolate and cassis on the nose, supported by spicy mineral and cigar box flavours. A rich, juicy palate.

Meerlust (Stellenbosch)

R600

A nose of intense cassis, plum and classic cedar wood-cigar box notes and dark fruit aromas. A full bodied palate impressively structured. Blackcurrant and plum fruit with refined tannins and natural acidity.

SANGIOVESE

Raka (Stanford)

R200

Soft, ruby with a slightly purple colour. Friendly savouriness with a hint of sour cherries. Tactfully oaked Lingerin finish.

MERLOT

MAN – Jan Fiskaal (Stellenbosch)

A classically styled Merlot, bold red-berry fruit and oak spice aromas with plush, ripe berry fruit and chocolate flavours. Soft, gentle tannins with a long finish.



Glenwood (Franschhoek)

An elegant, medium-bodied wine with rich, intense layers of chocolate, creamy mulberry and subtle tannins, with a hint of mint on the finish.



The Stellenbosch (Stellenbosch)

An elegant wine with intense mulberry and luscious cherry flavours, supported by supple tannins and perfectly balanced oak.

Muratie - Alberta Annemarie (Stellenbosch)

Ripe and fruity with a hint of leafiness and cinnamon spice. These sweet flavours are balanced by the acidity and ripe tannin. Good body and structure.

SHIRAZ

Bon Courage (Robertson)

Ripe red berry fruit reminiscent of spicy plum jam, complimented by pepper and vanilla. Full rounded mouth with soft tannins. Red berry flavours and spice follow through from the nose.



Oneiric - OH! Shiraz (Elgin)

Raspberry, red plum aromas. Cloves, white pepper notes with gently game characters. Rich and smooth textured.



Raka – Biography (Stanford)

Bouquet and palate, well balanced between integrated oak and fruit. White pepper on the nose, exploding into ripe plush fruit on the palate.

La Bri – Syrah (Franschhoek)

A rich purple colour, enticing with an explosive mix of violets, mint and thyme. Juicy and bright with a fresh palate of mulberries, mint and dark chocolate. Rich lasting fruit; elegant, unified tannins and fresh acidity.

PINOTAGE

Stellenrust (Stellenbosch)

Offering raspberry, ripe peach and black cherry flavours, subtle oak nuances, a ripe juice palate and a delicate lingering finish.



Simonsig (Stellenbosch)

Sweet scented aromas of red berries and blueberries and a touch of spice. Soft nuances of dried prunes and red cherries.

Altydgedacht (Durbanville)

Fragrant, wild berry & raspberry aromas and flavours with firm tannins to finish.



PINOT NOIR

Mr P – Pinot Noir by Iona (Elgin)



Elegant, fresh cherry and red berry nose. The palate is pure with lovely texture and focused sweet cherry fruit dominates with spicy undertones. Fresh and intense.

Newton Johnson (Hermanus)

R380

A typical full colour with deep, abundant flavours of black cherry, spice, and liquorice. A mineral, earthy character complements the long, savory finish.

ROSÉ AND BLANC DE NOIR

Dornier (Stellenbosch)

R145

Bursting with aromas of strawberries and raspberries. The palate is vivacious with a bright acidity and flavours of Turkish delight, sweet red berries and sour cherry. The finish is dry with a pleasant length.

Rickety Bridge (Franschhoek)



Tones of strawberry, Turkish delight and candy floss dominate the nose and palate with an elegant spicy finish. This full palate has an easy natural acidity.

L'Avenir – Far and Near Rosé De Pinotage (Stellenbosch)

R160

A floral, fruit-filled nose that radiates sweet strawberry and watermelon aromas, yet is surprisingly dry and refreshing on the palate.

WHITE BLENDS

Balance – Winemakers Selection Pinot Grigio (Worcester)

R125

This wine tempts with enticing aromas of melon which leads to a feast of fresh, lingering flavours of green apple and pear finished with a crisp acidity.

Buitenverwachting – Buiten Blanc (Constantia)

R145

This full bodied Sauv-Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters like ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

Morgenhof – Fantail Sauv/Chenin (Stellenbosch)

R155

On the nose and palate this wine shows refreshing flavours of lime, citrus and mango with a hint of floral tones. These flavours follow through onto a fruity, luscious palate which ends with a lingering crispness.

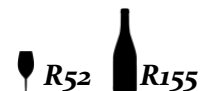
Haute Cabriere – Chard/Pinot Noir (Franschhoek)



Refined and elegant with a firm acidity giving direction. You will find an abundance of ripe zesty fruit with a delectable full mouth feel, in perfect balance of these two noble cultivars.

CHENIN BLANC

Welgemeend (Paarl)



Guavas, ripe apples and pears, abundantly present in this tropical fruit driven wine. A fresh acidity balances the fruit producing a wine pairing well with chicken, fish and veal.

Ernie Els – Big Easy (Stellenbosch)

R170

Oozing with ripe mango, litchi and guava. Layers of spice and a steely acidity add to the sleek texture and powerful embrace.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Raka (Stanford)

Light clear colour, aromas of tropical fruit with a hint of linden. An equal palate, with soft acidity and a lingering green finish.



Rustenberg – Stellenbosch (Stellenbosch)

Intrinsic Sauv Blanc characteristics of tropical fruits, melon and gooseberry. Underlying tones of pineapple and passion fruit on a fresh, crisp and well balanced palate of prodigious length.

Ataraxia (Hermanus)

Cool-climate minerality, pure, pungent, aromas, of tropical fruits, granadilla, pink grapefruit and gooseberry hints.



Springfield - Life from Stone (Robertson)

A vine rooted in 70% quartz stone is truly reflected in this wine. A flinty nose with mineral pallet growing with age.

Iona (Elgin)

Grapefruit, tropical fruit, gooseberry and kiwi over-lay herbal, floral undertones. Green apples and lime marmalade palate followed by great minerality.

CHARDONNAY

Balance – Winemakers Selection (Worcester)

Aromas of citrus, subtle underlying oak, a fresh acidity. A wonderful, complex wine.



La Vieg – Jezebelle (Hermanus)

Expressing the zip and texture of the clay on the palate and aromatic lime, white floral and mineral character nose. A seafood and white meat wine.



Constantia Uitsig (Constantia)

Un-wooded, complex aromas. Flavours of white fruits and pears. A palate of beautiful zestness, nuttiness and soft tannin structure, perfectly balanced.

ITALIAN SPARKLING WINES

Zonin Prosecco Brut (Italy)

Attractively intense, very fruity and aromatic with hints of wisteria flowers and Rennet apples. With extremely delicate almond notes.

Lambrusco (Italy)

Fine and persistent foam, a lively ruby red colour. Appealing aroma.

SPARKLING WINES

Steenburg – Sparkling Sauv Blanc (Constantia)

A delicious palate fruity and fresh, a herbaceous nose of Apple with aromas of passion fruit, litchi, guava and mango. Fresh and fizzy.

Simonsig – Kaapse Vonkel MCC Brut (Stellenbosch)

R310

A limpid wine has a straw undertone. Sizzling notes of white peach contrast with red berries. A palate of white peach and apples. A fine balance of fruit and acidity, beautiful and elegant.

Wildeckrans – Brut Rosé MCC (Overberg)

  R410

A nose of fine red berries intermingle with biscuit notes and the beauty of strawberries, raspberries and cherries on the palate.

CHAMPAGNE

Moët Chandon (NV Brut)

R850

Three champagne grape varieties express their essence.

Veuve Clicquot (Yellow Label Brut)

R920

Notes of fruit and aromas of brioche and vanilla.

Moët Chandon - Rosé (NV Brut)

R1050

Scent of spice, red fruits and wild strawberries.

Veuve Clicquot (Rosé Label Brut)

R1100

Aromas of fresh red fruits with biscuity notes of dried fruits and Viennese pastries.

Dom Perignon (Champagne Brut)

R3000

Paradoxically concentrated yet creamy, it is energetic and warm in the mouth.

DESSERT WINES

Paul Cluver Reisling Noble Late Harvest (Elgin)

A very expressive nose, with apricot and pineapple aromas dominating. Soft cardamom pod fragrances and orange blossom are noticeable too. All these characteristics follow through onto the luscious, creamy palate which finishes clean.

Klein Constantia Vin De Constance (Constantia)

Rich and unctuous, yet superbly racy, this offers a gorgeous panoply of dried apricot, fig, mango and quince flavors, underscored by a lively blood orange note and backed by a long, ginger- and green tea-filled finish. Youthfully tight, this should cruise for some time in the cellar.
